

Ukulele Rote 1

Song - *Going Down The Road*

Objective: To teach students the melody and words of the song “Going Down The Road”, a song that I originally heard from South Park. Using different emotions, we will get the students to be creative with lyrics.

Materials:

- Ukulele
- Copy of the Lyrics to Going Down The Road

Procedure:

1	Review the TAB of ukulele C,F, and G	1 min
Notes: Students were able to figure out TABs of chords pretty fast		
2	Start by playing the chords in rhythm	1 min
Notes: Students picked up on rhythm fast		
3	Have students repeat the chords in rhythm	1.5 mins
Notes: Able to repeat it		
4	Teach students melody. “I’m Going Down the road feeling...”	1 min
Notes: Students seemed to really enjoy the lyrics. They were interested in the origin.		
5	Add Ukulele	1 min
Notes: <i>Make sure that you are solid on marching and singing yourself</i>		
6	Go through different emotions, ‘bad’, ‘mad’, ‘tired’, ‘hungry’	X
Notes: Students seemed to have fun participating in this part. Adding their own input seemed to be something they really enjoyed.		

Assessment: Ability for students to be able to repeat the chords in rhythm while singing a melody with small changes each time done

Lyrics:
